“Should I forgive someone 7 times?”

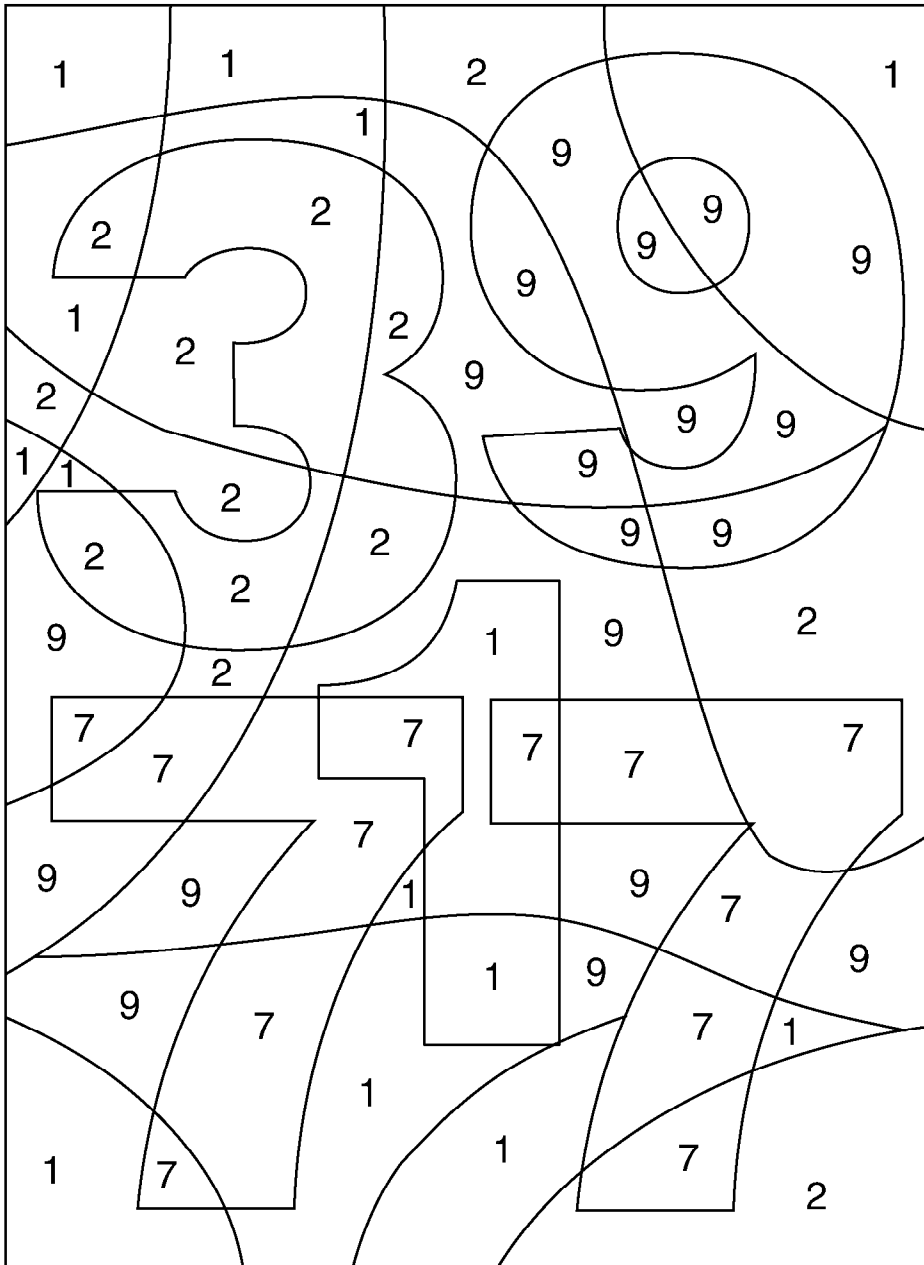
Find 7 “7’s” in the picture.
