All: to live each day as if it was the full final day of our extraordinary ordinary lives.

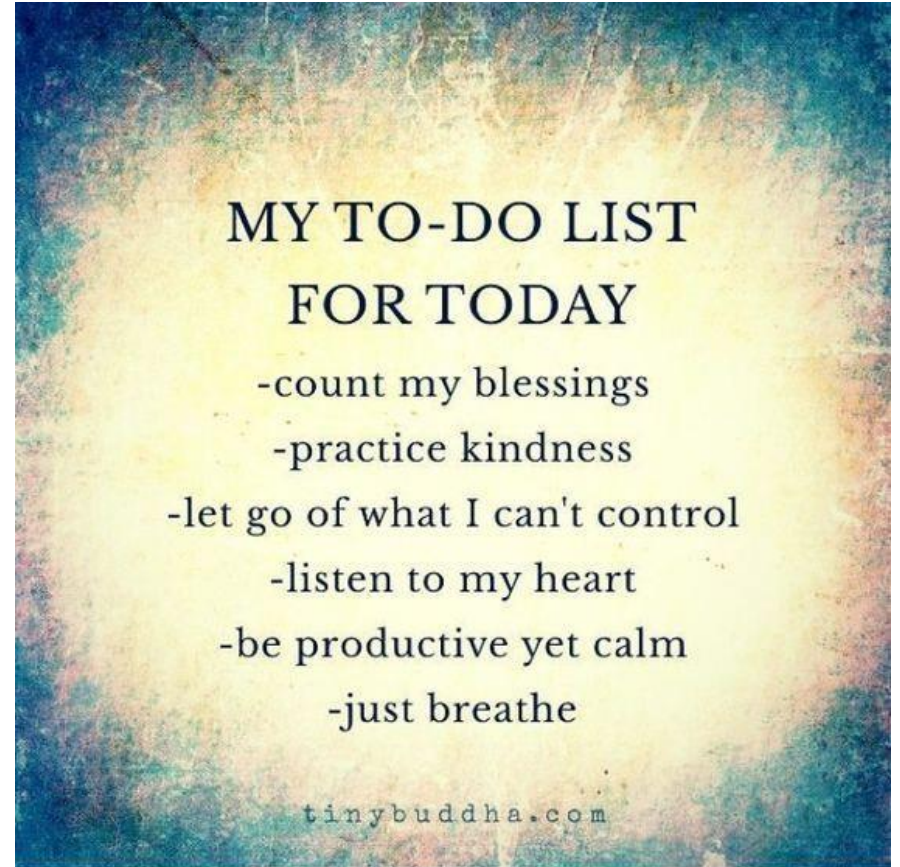
Together: We’re all travelling through time together and all we can do is relish this remarkable ride. Amen.
